### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**MOTION:** Rick Carr made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 1, 2023, meeting, seconded by Fred Hollmann. All in favor, the motion passed 5-0-0.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Shelter Plans: The Board discussed the pros and cons of three different shelter designs up for consideration and reached a consensus.

**MOTION:** Dan Phirman made a motion to purchase the PlayPros gable style shelter with installation included, seconded by Jenny Vildibil. All in favor, the motion passed 5-0-0.

The Board was uncertain about the oversight fees proposed by CT and wanted clarification of the services included before approving them.

- Headwall Project Grant: Mr. Plummer is working with CT to submit a grant proposal to help finance this project in 2024/25. The deadline for submissions is May 31.
