Dog Days Recap: This event was held on August 24, with 74 dogs registered and several vendors participating. Weather and attendance were both much better than 2023.

Halloween Walk: Mrs. Wagner has been working on a flyer that is nearly ready for the event on October 26. She is also working on ideas for more business involvement for the event and will have more to discuss at the October meeting.

Discuss/Update Bylaws: Some Board members did not have the opportunity to review the Bylaws and were not ready to discuss any changes, so this will be discussed at the October meeting.

NEW BUSINESS.

Recreational Director Update: Mrs. Wagner provided the following updates: Mrs. Tarter would like to streamline the process for shelter rentals and possibly incorporate an online reservation process or calendar to reduce staff time involvement for 2025. The new rental fee structure may be delayed until this is implemented.

City Administrator Update: Mr. Plummer gave updates on the progress for the new city building complex.

Park Usage Ideas: Discussion started with a question on whether the area and trails near the lower dam could be used for mountain biking and if there would be any interest. Two ideas were
