### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**MOTION:** Laura Fincher made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 5, 2025, meeting, seconded by Rick Carr. Motion passed 4-0-0.

- Park Use Survey: The Board reviewed the questions that Laura presented and gave input for improvements. The Board plans to have the City release the survey from mid-April to June 8 and it will be accessed via QR codes posted around the park.
- 2025 Event Dates: Kim Wagner announced the following event dates: Egg Hunt on April 12, Arbor Day on April 26, and Kids at Parks Day on May 17.
- **Budget:** The funds remaining in the budget will go towards the pickleball courts and other expenses will be held until the next fiscal year, if possible.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Seating for New Shelter: Since the grant has not been closed and paid out, the seating is on hold.
- Recreational Director Update: Mrs. Wagner said she has received feedback on the need for playground equipment for very young kids to replace the train that was removed.
