



ORDINANCE 2026-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, REPEALING SECTION 33.06 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO PURCHASING POLICIES, HAVING BEEN REPLACED BY THE PURCHASING AND PROCUREMENT POLICY PROMULGATED BY THE MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER 2026-01.

WHEREAS, Mayor Schabell has issued his Executive Order 2026-01, which promulgated and revised the City's Personnel Policy Employee Handbook by, among other things, adding Appendix H – the City's new Purchasing and Procurement Policy; and

WHEREAS, the City's new Purchasing and Procurement Policy promulgated by Executive Order 2026-01 replaces the Purchasing Policies contained in Section 33.06 of the City Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to repeal in Section 33.06 of the City Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 33.06 of the City Code of Ordinances pertaining to Purchasing Policies is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication and upon the effective date of Executive Order 2026-01.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance may be published by Summary.

SECTION 4: If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION 5: All Ordinances or parts of any Ordinances in conflict therewith, to the extent of such conflict, if any, are hereby repealed

SECTION 6: The foregoing Ordinance was introduced by Council Member Stacey Graus, was read,

passed and adopted by Council of the City of Alexandria, Kentucky, meeting in **regular sessions on the 5th day of March, 2026, and on the 19th day of March, 2026, with 6 Yes votes, 0 No votes, and 0 Abstentions**, and was thereafter approved by the Mayor and ordered published in Summary according to law.
